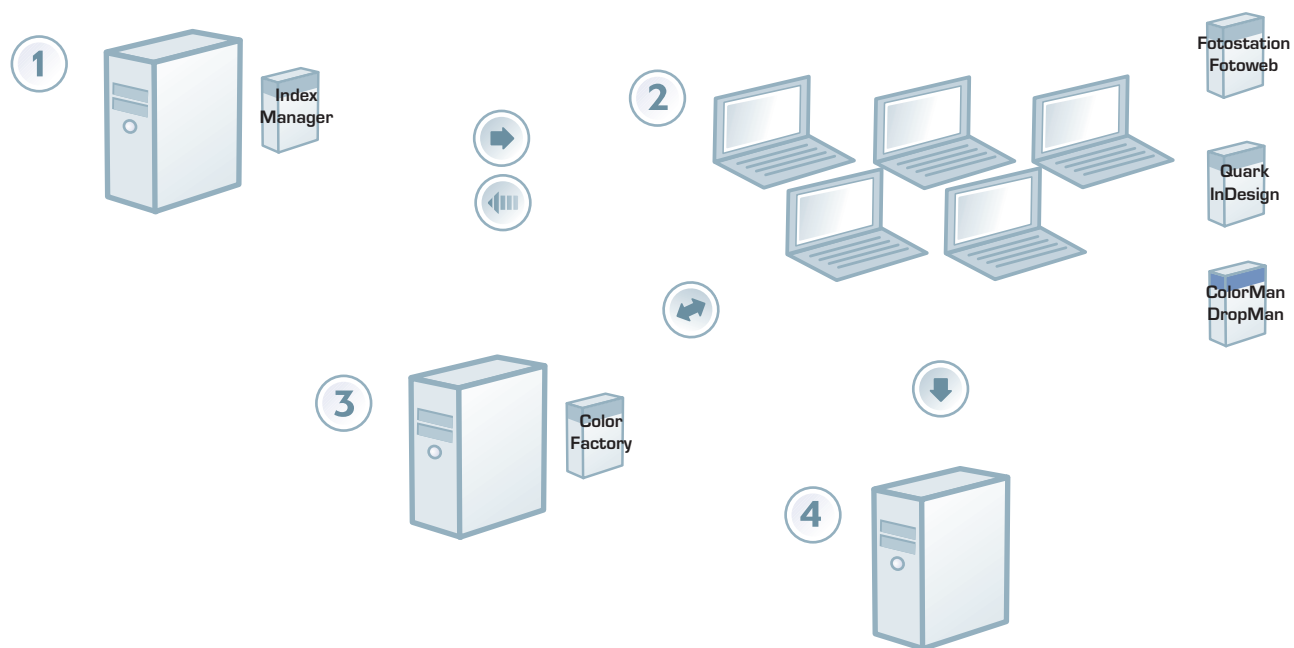


## Example of a workflow using ColorMan.



- 1 All images are checked into Index Manager where they are categorized and indexes are built. All the images in Index Manager is saved as rgb.jpg.
- 2 All the images in Index Manager are now searchable in a lot of different ways such as categories, photographers or free text search. Fotostation or Fotoweb is used to search for the images you want to use. Drag the images from Fotostation or Fotoweb and drop the images, and optionally include the caption text, in your layout. If you are using FotoStation, ColorMan is the only plug-in needed, if Fotoweb is used you have to have DropMan aswell. The images is edited using the layout program standard features and are sent to Color Factory for the repro. If the caption texts is used and edited, ColorMan can update the caption text in the IPTC of the image stored in Index Manager.
- 3 The images ColorMan sent are handled by Color Factory according to the settings made for the printout. Normally a CMYK EPS or TIFF is created for the print job.
- 4 ColorMan recognizes that Color Factory has produced a print ready image, it fetches and remounts the image in the layout. Print or export the layout as a EPS / PDF.
