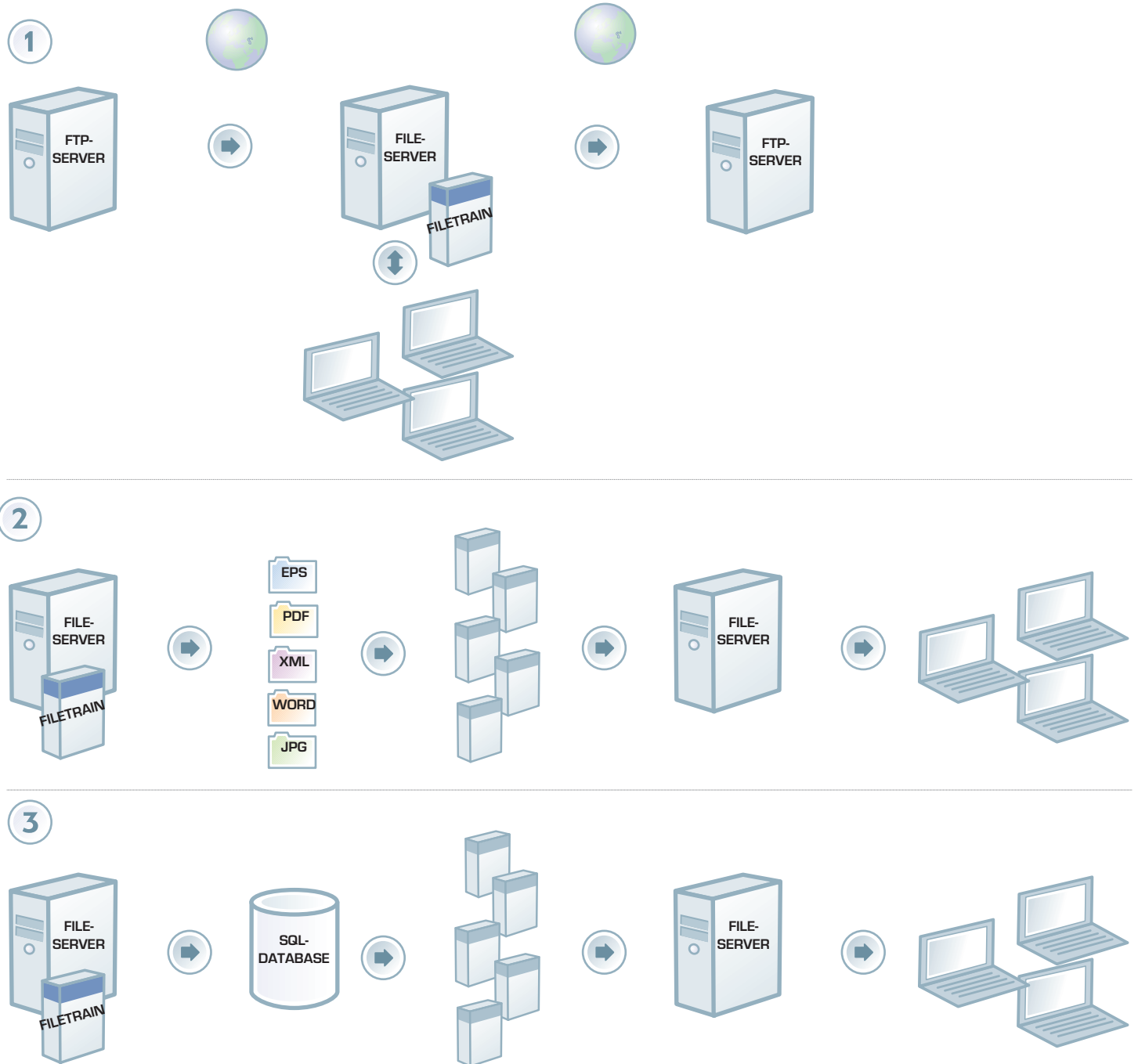


Some examples of workflows built with FileTrain.



- 1 Let FileTrain watch FTP-servers around the world, fetching the files you need and filter files you don't. Sort the files and distribute them to your fileserver, send e-mail to the users telling the files has arrived. When the work with these files is done, the users can simply put the files to different folders, watched by FileTrain, and the files can automatically be routed wherever you like, on the LAN or on any external FTP-server.
- 2 Many offices has some kind of entrance for files from the outside. Have FileTrain to fetch the files and filter and sort the according to your settings. Different types of files can be routed to different systems, e.g. preflight systems, image systems, document systems, before entering the file server.
- 3 Just about the same as example 2 but here is an SQL-database used to give FileTrain instructions on what to do with the different types of files entering the system. To do this, a customized SQL-plugin is required.

Practically any workflow regarding files and folders can be configured with FileTrain, this is only a few examples.
